# A Message from Our CEO



At Vegas Stronger, our mission is rooted in the belief that recovery is possible when people are given compassionate care, evidence-based treatment, and the support they need to rebuild their lives. Every day, we work to break the cycle of addiction, untreated mental illness, and homelessness by meeting people where they are and guiding them toward lasting stability.

This year, our impact continued to grow. In 2025, Vegas Stronger served 2,062 individuals through our programs, representing an increase from the previous year. Through our broader network of services, including NMHS and ABC Therapy, we helped 4,966 Las Vegas residents access care and recovery resources. We published our Outcomes Report study which includes findings that participation in the Vegas Stronger treatment program is associated with meaningful improvements in sobriety, housing stability, employment, and psychological well-being.

The generosity of our community continues to make this work possible. In 2025, more than \$400,000 in financial and in-kind donations supported Vegas Stronger's mission, helping fund our dedicated staff, expand treatment and outreach services, and provide essential daily needs, including feeding more than 100 individuals each day. These contributions ensure that the people who come through our doors receive not only treatment, but also dignity, nourishment, and the support needed to rebuild their lives.

None of this work would be possible without the commitment of our staff, volunteers, community partners, and supporters who believe in this mission. Together, we are building a stronger, healthier Las Vegas: one life, one recovery, and one opportunity at a time.

# Our Mission



## Transforming Lives Through Evidence-Based, Compassionate Care.

At Vegas Stronger, our mission is to reduce homelessness by addressing its root causes—substance use disorders and untreated mental health conditions. We are dedicated to providing comprehensive, integrated, and evidence-based treatment to the most underserved populations in Las Vegas.

We believe that everyone deserves access to quality behavioral healthcare, regardless of their circumstances. By offering immediate access to care, longer treatment episodes, and a holistic recovery approach, we help individuals reclaim their lives, rebuild their confidence, and reintegrate into society with stability and purpose.

We envision a Las Vegas where no individual is left behind: where anyone struggling with addiction or mental illness has access to the care, resources, and support they need to achieve lasting recovery.

Our approach is built on the belief that homelessness, addiction, and mental health struggles are interconnected. We work to break the cycle by providing long-term treatment, social reintegration services, and advocacy for systemic change that breaks the cycle of addiction and homelessness.

# What We Do

To fulfill our mission, we have developed a comprehensive, multi-faceted approach that prioritizes accessibility, effectiveness, and long-term success.

Our key strategies include:



## Immediate Access to Care

We eliminate barriers to treatment by providing same-day access to addiction and mental health services, ensuring that individuals receive the help they need without unnecessary delays.



## Longer Treatment Durations for Lasting Results

We extend treatment episodes beyond industry standards, offering an average of 5.5 months of care to maximize success rates and prevent relapse.



## Street & Shelter Interventions

Our outreach teams actively engage with the homeless population, providing crisis intervention, resources, and connections to long-term treatment.



## Integrated Behavioral Healthcare

Our treatment programs address both addiction and co-occurring mental health disorders, providing dual diagnosis treatment, medication-assisted therapy (MAT), and trauma-informed care.



## Holistic Recovery Support

We address the full spectrum of needs—from housing and employment assistance to fitness, nutrition, and peer mentorship programs—ensuring that every client receives the support necessary to achieve lasting stability and independence.

**At Vegas Stronger, we don't just treat addiction — we work to transform lives, rebuild communities, and advocate for systemic improvements in behavioral healthcare. Our commitment to lasting change includes:**

- Educate the public on best practices for addressing homelessness and addiction.

- Advocate for policy changes that expand access to quality treatment and long-term recovery services.
- Foster a culture of empowerment, support, and resilience within the Las Vegas community.



# Who We Are

As we grow in the Las Vegas community, and throughout the United States, we are excited to be able to provide more opportunities for individuals to receive the services they need, with the quality care we are known for. In addition to Vegas Stronger, The Stronger Family includes:

## Nevada Stronger



This initiative expands comprehensive, evidence-based addiction treatment, mental health care, and homelessness recovery services into rural and underserved communities across Nevada.

## Reno Stronger



The Reno-based behavioral health organization provides treatment and recovery services for individuals experiencing addiction, mental illness, and homelessness. Through evidence-based care, therapy, and supportive services, it helps individuals stabilize and rebuild their lives.

## Neubauer Mental Health Services



The outpatient behavioral health practice is dedicated to making a positive and measurable impact in the lives of individuals and families across Las Vegas. They provide comprehensive, research-supported treatment for psychological, emotional, and behavioral concerns in children, adolescents, and adults.

## ABC Therapy



For over 30 years, they've helped thousands of individuals in Southern Nevada navigate mental health treatment, legal requirements, and emotional recovery, in English and Spanish, with culturally sensitive, professional counseling.

# Our 13 Essential Elements

At Vegas Stronger, we offer more than simply traditional group therapy. Along with our clinical rooms, our facility hosts a boxing gym, coffee shop, bookstore, bicycle ministry, salon, and a yoga room. We believe in an integrated, evidence-based model of treatment, as we know treating the whole person is necessary to cure the disease of addiction. Our tenets of treatment are described in our “13 Elements”- the principles we believe are essential to recovery.

## **Counseling and Psychiatric Treatment**

Vegas Stronger currently offers four modes of group treatment of Level I and Level II services: Outpatient Program (OP), Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP), Mental Health, and Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP). At Vegas Stronger our clinicians utilize Motivational Interviewing (MI), Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT), Dialectical Behavioral Therapy (DBT), Contingency Management, Acceptance Commitment Therapy (ACT), Eye Movement Desensitization Reprocessing (EMDR), Rational Emotive Behavioral Therapy (REBT).

## **Case Management**

At Vegas Stronger, case managers serve as a critical bridge between clients and community resources. They work directly with clients to address barriers that may interfere with recovery, including housing instability, lack of medical care, unemployment, and limited access to social services. Case managers assist clients in securing housing, connecting with primary medical providers, enrolling in health insurance and other benefits, and obtaining necessities required for stability during treatment. Vegas Stronger currently employs five full-time case workers.

## **Medication Assisted Treatment**

At Vegas Stronger, we offer naltrexone, buprenorphine, acamprosate and bupropion. MAT treatment is utilized in combination with counseling and behavioral therapies; these can vastly improve the outcomes of our clients. All of the medications we offer are evidence-based treatment options.

## **Drug Testing**

At Vegas Stronger we drug test our clients (via urinalysis) randomly at least once a week, based on clinician direction. Drug tests are used throughout our treatment process for a variety of reasons. First, we use drug tests during the client’s Biopsychosocial preliminary examination to determine if there are any drugs in the client’s system so they can be sent to medical detoxification (if necessary) and determine the appropriate level of care. We realize those suffering from substance-abuse disorders may not be entirely honest when entering our program. They also may be in a state where they do not know or remember which substances they have consumed. It is especially important to know what drugs are in the client’s system before prescribing any medication assisted treatment medications, as they may interact with the substances in the client’s system, resulting in serious side effects. When these random drug tests will occur is difficult for the client to predict and can prevent relapse while in treatment. They can facilitate a lifestyle free from harmful substances.



# Our 13 Essential Elements

## **Primary Medical Care**

A majority of our clients do not have access to primary medical care upon admission. As many of them are homeless, they have not seen a physician for a significant period of time. Obtaining primary medical care for our clients while in treatment provides benefits to both the patients and the clinicians. Our case managers work with the client's insurance provider (usually Medicaid) to find a primary care physician for all those without.

## **Housing**

Stable housing is perhaps the most important part of recovery. Having a roof over your head each night provides structure and can make the recovery process easier, and alleviates the need to "cope" with alcohol or drugs. Vegas Stronger works with community providers (both NGO's and government agencies) to provide housing for all our clients within one week of admittance. As our program is contingency-based, we only provide housing to patients enrolled at Vegas Stronger.

## **Spirituality**

The role of spirituality is helpful in aiding recovery from substance-use disorders. Spirituality has been shown to help clients find renewed purpose, promote accountability, connect them with something outside themselves, increase compassion and humility, and promote greater mindfulness.

## **Peer Recovery Coaching**

Peer recovery support is the giving of non-clinical assistance to support clients in recovery. Relatively new to treatment programs, this support now plays an important role in a holistic treatment program. Peer recovery coaches have attained long-term sobriety and are professionally licensed. Vegas Stronger currently employs ten full-time recovery coaches, and will expand this number in 2026.

## **Recovery Meetings**

Our clients are encouraged by clinicians to attend 12-step meetings while in treatment in order to support and strengthen the treatment they are receiving at Vegas Stronger and extend their Recovery community for long-term Recovery support. We host NA meetings in our facility every day of the week.

## **Salon Services / Fitness and Yoga / Nutritional Services**

Exercise reduces the likelihood of relapse through several behavioral and neurobiological consequences of exercise in all phases of recovery. To improve our clients' self-perception and reduce relapse potential, we offer salon and fitness services. Volunteers from the community visit our facility biweekly to provide free salon services to our clients and our gym is available for use six days a week. We employ two trainers on staff to lead boxing and general fitness classes and also offer yoga classes.

## **Service to Others**

Service is a tenet of any recovery group. Through service to others, one can remember where they came from and are less likely to return. They are also likely to have higher self-esteem and suffer less from depression.



# Our Impact

## In 2025 Vegas Stronger served 2,062 individuals!

Of the 2,692 individuals that came to our 916 N. Main St. location last year in need, 76.6% were in need of SUD treatment or mental health treatment and were admitted. The others we referred out to our wide community of partners to make sure they received other resources they were in need of.

**That's a 25.96% increase from 2024**

Additionally, we helped **1,655** clients through ABC Therapy and **1,249** clients at NMHS.

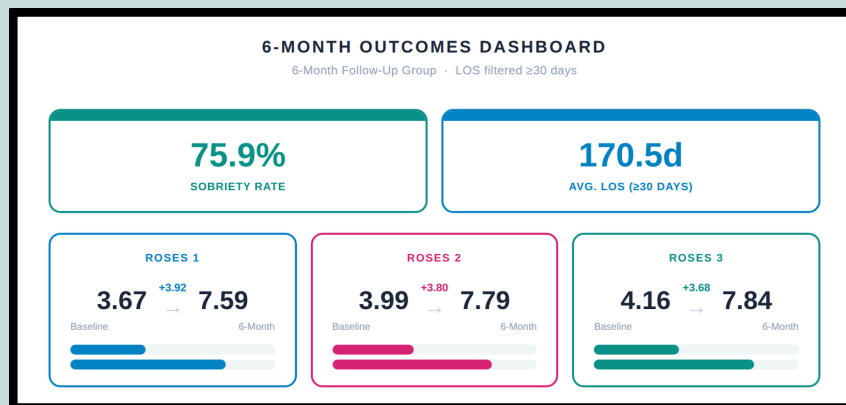
# Vegas Stronger Outcomes

In 2025 alone, Vegas Stronger served more than 2,000 individuals seeking treatment for substance use and related behavioral health challenges. The present outcomes report evaluates the effectiveness of the Vegas Stronger Thirteen Elements Treatment Model using program data collected between 2021 and 2025. A total of **2,613** individuals completed an intake assessment during this period. Of this population, **83** participants completed a six-month follow-up survey in 2025 and were included in longitudinal outcome analyses. Outcomes were measured across several domains including **substance use, housing stability, employment, and overall well-being** using the Rating of Outcome Scale (ROS).

Results indicate strong improvements across multiple indicators of recovery. **At the six-month follow-up, 75.9% of participants reported abstinence from all substances, stability also improved substantially.** At baseline, 51.8% of participants reported experiencing homelessness, whereas **at six months 65% of those of participants were living in stable housing, including independent housing and supported housing environments.**

Employment outcomes similarly demonstrated positive change. At baseline, 21.6% of participants were employed, while **at the six-month follow-up 41.5% reported active employment**, representing a nearly twenty-percentage-point increase in workforce participation. **Improvements were also observed in mental and emotional well-being.** Paired-samples analyses of ROS scores revealed statistically significant improvements across all three subscales ( $p < .001$ ), indicating meaningful gains in psychological functioning and overall quality of life.

Taken together, these findings suggest that participation in the Vegas Stronger treatment program is associated with meaningful improvements in sobriety, housing stability, employment, and psychological well-being. These outcomes support the effectiveness of the Vegas Stronger Thirteen Elements Treatment Model and highlight the importance of comprehensive, community-integrated treatment approaches for individuals experiencing substance use disorders and housing instability.

# Growth in 2025



In 2025, Vegas Stronger continued to expand its holistic, treatment-first approach to addressing addiction, mental health, and homelessness in Southern Nevada. Building on its evidence-based model of integrated behavioral healthcare and community outreach, the organization launched several new initiatives designed to deepen engagement and strengthen long-term recovery outcomes. These included the introduction of a **Theater Program** and **Women’s Group** to foster community, creativity, and peer support in recovery, as well as the **START Youth Program** to reach younger populations at risk. Vegas Stronger also strengthened its regional impact through new collaborations, including a **partnership with the Clark County Detention Center** to lower rates of recidivism and provide treatment to individuals immediately upon release, and the opening of the **Vegas Stronger Chapel** to provide additional space for connection, healing, and support. To further address the critical link between recovery and stable housing, the organization began utilizing the **Regency Hotel** as transitional housing for individuals moving from treatment toward independent living. Together, these initiatives expanded Vegas Stronger’s capacity to meet people where they are and provide the comprehensive services needed to break cycles of addiction and homelessness.



# Events of the Year!

In 2025, Vegas Stronger brought the community together through dozens of events that raised awareness, celebrated recovery, and expanded access to services. From Polar Plunges and Fights of Fury to Earth Day community cleanups and Pop-Up Homeless Resource Fairs, these gatherings mobilized supporters and connected individuals with critical resources. The organization also hosted its Stories of Hope and Purpose Fundraising Luncheon and marked a major milestone with a ribbon cutting celebrating seven years of service alongside the Vegas Chamber, community partners, and supporters. Together, these events highlighted the powerful stories of recovery made possible through Vegas Stronger and reinforced the community partnerships that continue to drive its mission forward.



# Commitment to the Future

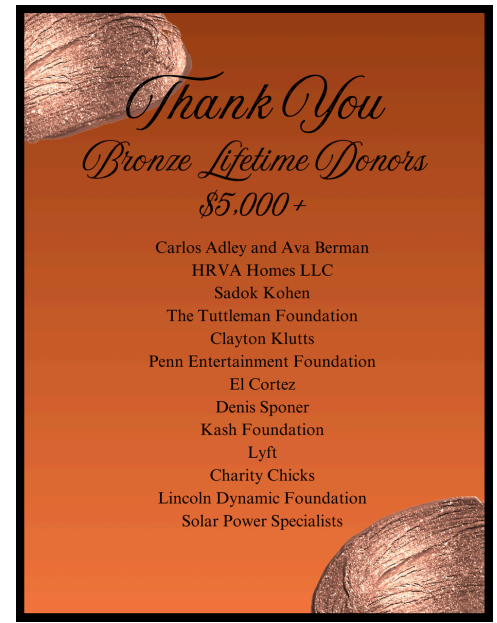
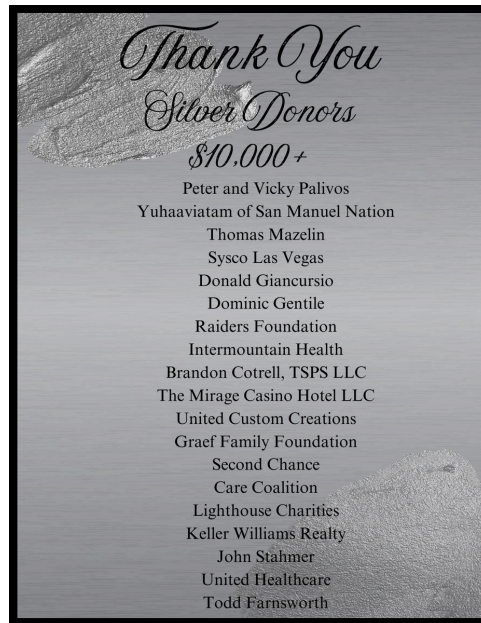
